Rock Creek Baptist Church provides as a service to the community a van service that brings youth to church activities when available. The following guidelines must be followed in order to ensure safety of all passengers.

- 1) Youth must obey the driver and other adults riding along
- 2) Safety belts must be worn
- 3) Youth must communicate a need to be picked up by the deadline set forth for that activity
- 4) Youth will be dropped off where they were picked up. Unless a different drop off location has been pre-arranged and RCBC is satisfied the custodian/legal guardian has authorized it. We cannot take the word of a child.
- 5) If youth are dropped off at a location that is not a residence, our insurance requires that we have a visual confirmation with a parent/guardian and they are at the drop off location.
- 6) Youth must be ready when the van arrives and not delaying in getting on board
- 7) Youth must be respectful to everyone on board and to others on the road

Failure to follow any of these provisions may result in loss of riding privileges.

The driver and other chaperones are not responsible for where a youth goes after being dropped off at the proper place, nor are they responsible for a youth arranging to be picked up at a place they shouldn't have been at.
